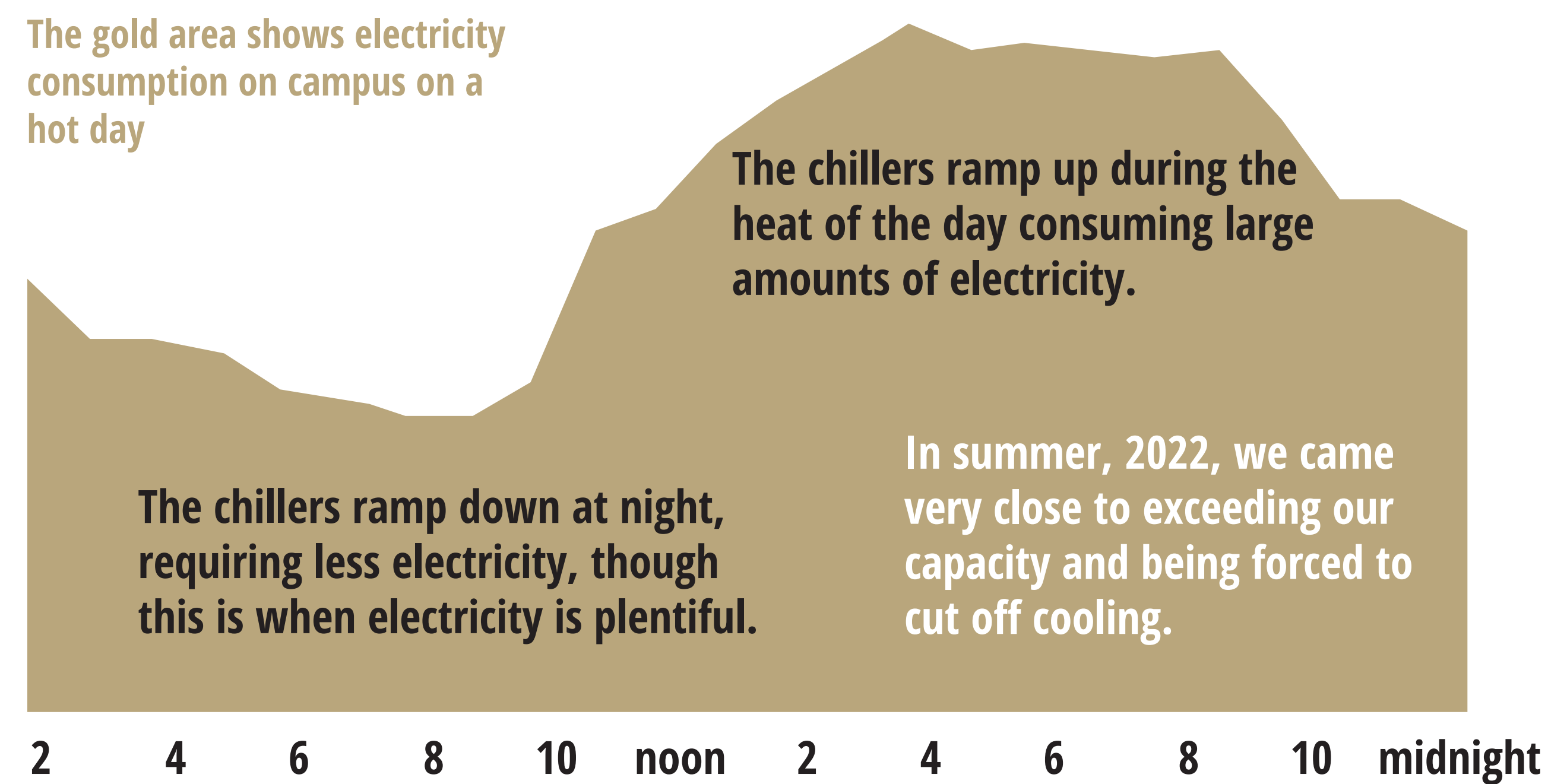


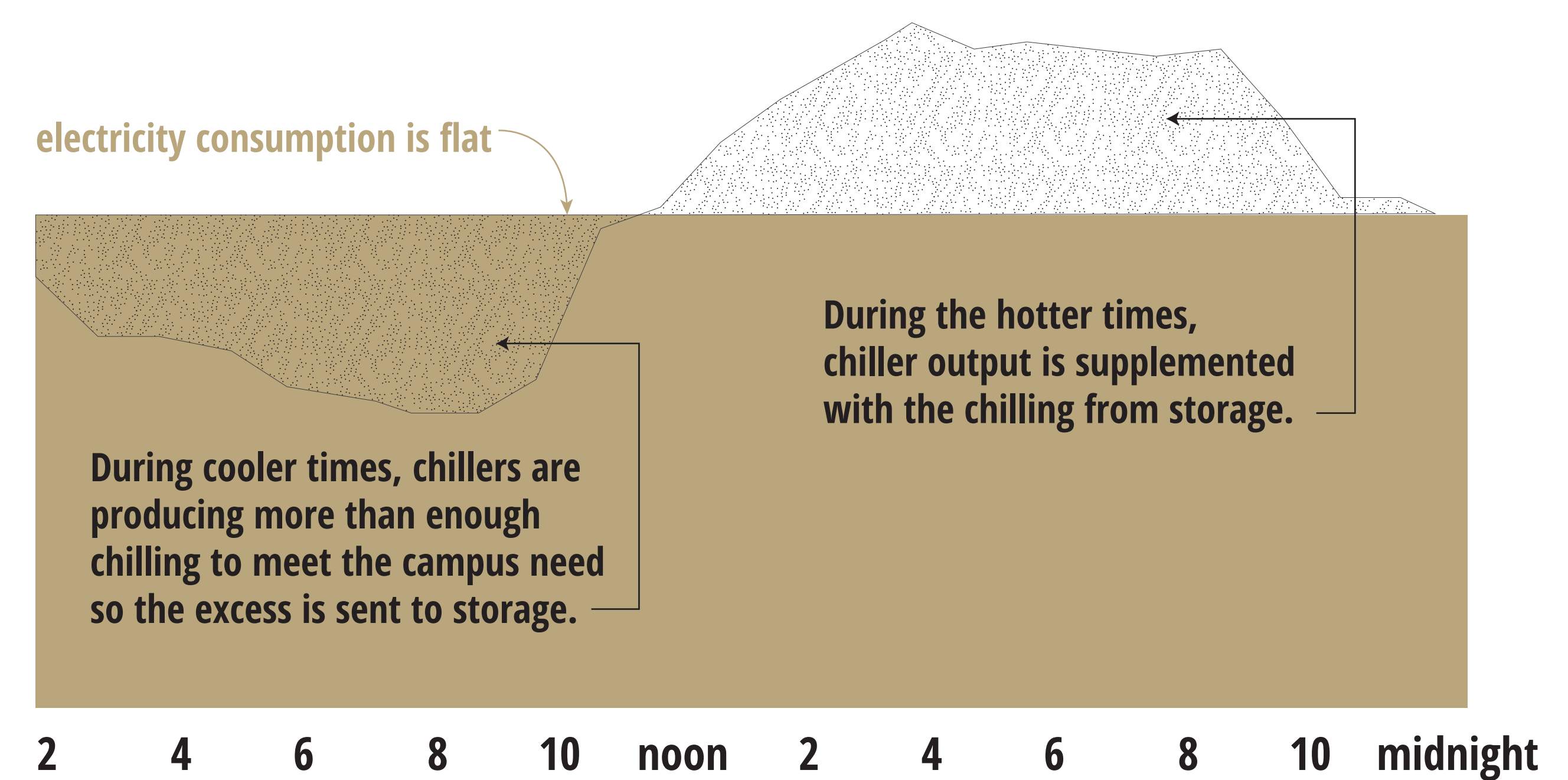
# BENEFITS OF CHILLED WATER STORAGE

With hotter summers and a growing campus, we need more chilling capacity. However there is a limit to how much electricity we can pull into campus at a given moment and traditional chillers require large amounts of electricity. As a result, even if we had additional chillers we couldn't use them during the hottest times because we couldn't supply them with electricity. A thermal storage tank which can hold chilled water until it is needed, can address this challenge.
